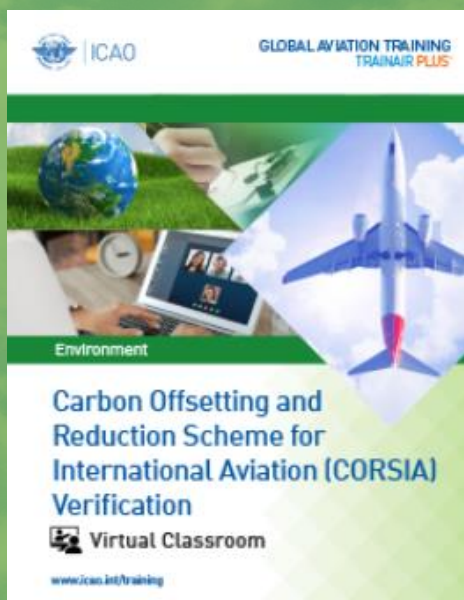




Raising Awareness of ICAO's Training Portfolio in ENV.


