EXPLANATORY NOTES

Panel 1: 10 years of SAPs. Lessons learned

In this Panel, the topic of discussion and debate will focus on the lessons learned in these 10 years of preparation of the Action Plans for the Reduction of CO₂ emissions. It will be important to highlight the difficulties faced in the preparation of the SAPs, the methodology implemented to overcome these difficulties, and the achievements made with the implementation of the SAPs, both qualitative and quantitative.

Panel 2: Contribution of SAPs in the construction of a sustainable and environmentally friendly aviation. Eco-efficient airports and alternative fuels.

The objective of this Panel is to present the process of implantation of the culture of environment protection in aviation activities. It would be important to be able to form a panel with aerodrome operators, air operators, other industries involved in aviation, and the presentation of topics related to carbon footprint evaluation, implementation of the use of clean energy mechanisms, alternative fuels, etc.

Panel 3: Roadmap for the preparation and updating of SAPs in the States.

The discussions in this Panel should revolve around the challenges for SAPs, their preparation, evaluation and updating. Methodology should be stated that could be applied to verify the validity of the measures stated in the action plans, at the time of saving CO₂ emissions and quantifying these savings. Likewise, analyze the continuity of the measures or the planning of other measures to be introduced in each triennium of updating them.

Panel 4: Interaction of Civil Aviation Master Plans (CAMPs) with SAPs

Presentations and discussions should focus on the link that should exist between CAMPs and SAPs.

Panel 5: Seminar Conclusions

This Panel should be made up of high authorities of the States and of the Industry, and express their opinions on those discussed in the five panels, in addition to issuing conclusions or recommendations that allow progress towards the final objective of ICAO in the field of the environment. which is to work with carbon neutral from 2020.
