SUMMARY

This information paper presents the information made available to the SAM State of a national recovery plan monitoring center on the ICAO SAM website and encourages States to designate a contact point for the provision of national recovery plans recovery.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. During Session #1 of the Collaborative Development Groups of the “SAM States Recovery Strategy versus the COVID – 19”, one of the task forces identified the need to make available to States a monitoring mechanism and access to official plans recovery to increase certainty for aviation stakeholders.

1.2. A highly intuitive interactive map to access States' recovery plans and other information were made available to the SAM States, where sources of information are clearly identified.

1.3. Reliable and timely access to recovery plans will significantly increase stakeholder certainty and provide an opportunity to identify conflict areas in interfaces and interactions between regulators, service providers, and health agencies.

2. ANALYSIS

2.1. Stakeholders need to have access to the SAM States' recovery plans and use these policies and procedures to develop their effort to continue or restart the operation. In the process of developing the strategy, it is very important to identify measures that have the potential to provoke conflict in the recovery process.

2.2. In identifying potential conflict, the stakeholder should use regional collaborative mechanisms to address and resolve conflicts, arguing appropriately and consistently.

2.3. The board of access and monitoring of the national plans is represented on a map of the South American region, placing an icon of access to each SAM State identifying the four main sources of information:

- a) State's Action Plan;
- b) COVID-19 information for each State from the World Health Organization (WHO);
- c) COVID-19 information for each State from the United Nations Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC);

d) COVID-19 general information for each State from Wikipedia.

2.4. Also, a letter was sent to the SAM States requesting their support to appoint, by 20 May this year, a liaison officer on communication matters, whose task will be to confirm the validity of the information collected by the GHS Office and made available to all interested parties.

2.5. Additionally, it is planned that the interactive map includes, for each State, a link to the Civil Aviation Authorities (AAC) that includes information and requirements related to the reactivation of national and international operations, and other information related to the current situation that is deemed convenient. For this purpose, the AAC's should establish a specific address within their website, where they include, or will include when available, the specifications for the reactivation of operations, requirements, forms, etc. Once this address is established, it must be provided to this Regional Office for incorporation into the interactive map.

3. SUGGESTED ACTION

3.1. Suggested to the Virtual Meeting of Directors General of Civil Aviation of SAM States:

- a) take note of the information presented in this information note;
- b) encourage States to designate a focal point for communication; and
- c) foster AACs to consider the creation of a specific address within its website, where the specifications for the reactivation of national and international operations, requirements, forms, etc. are included, or will be included when available, for incorporation into the interactive map.
