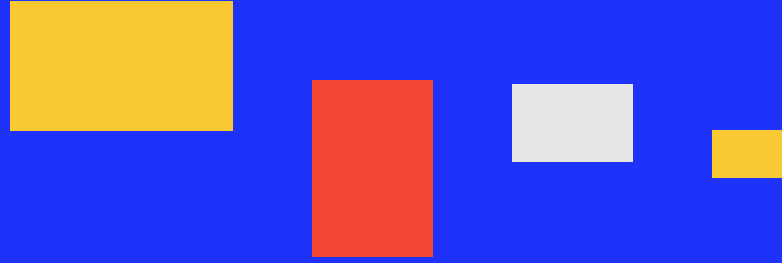

Critical Criteria for Health Apps

What do I need to enter the country?

Where do I get a test?

Do I need a vaccine?

Do I need a paper or digital certificate?

What about for re-entry?

How do I send my COVID-19 test certificates to the airline?

Do travelers have the correct COVID-19 requirements?

How do we let passengers know what they need to travel?

How can we cope with the amount of paper processing that will be required for paper testing and vaccine certificates?



How can we ensure passengers have the correct COVID-19 requirements?

Are the COVID certificates being presented legitimate?

How can we be sure the COVID-19 test or vaccine belongs to the traveler?

Digital apps for aviation should meet key critical criteria

1. Secure and private
2. Accurate
3. Verifiable
4. Link with travel processes current and future



Secure and private

Highest standards of data security and privacy for passengers

- There should be no central database.
- All data should be stored on the user's own phone.
- Passengers should have full control over their own data on their phone and can choose to share it with airlines and other parties.



Accurate

Comprehensive COVID-19 rules and regulations database

- To support the safe restart of aviation passengers, airlines and govts need to know what COVID-19 measures are needed to travel to a particular destination.
- It's important that the global registry of health requirements in travel apps is comprehensive and reliable.



Verifiable

Verified Identity management is critical to reduce certificate fraud

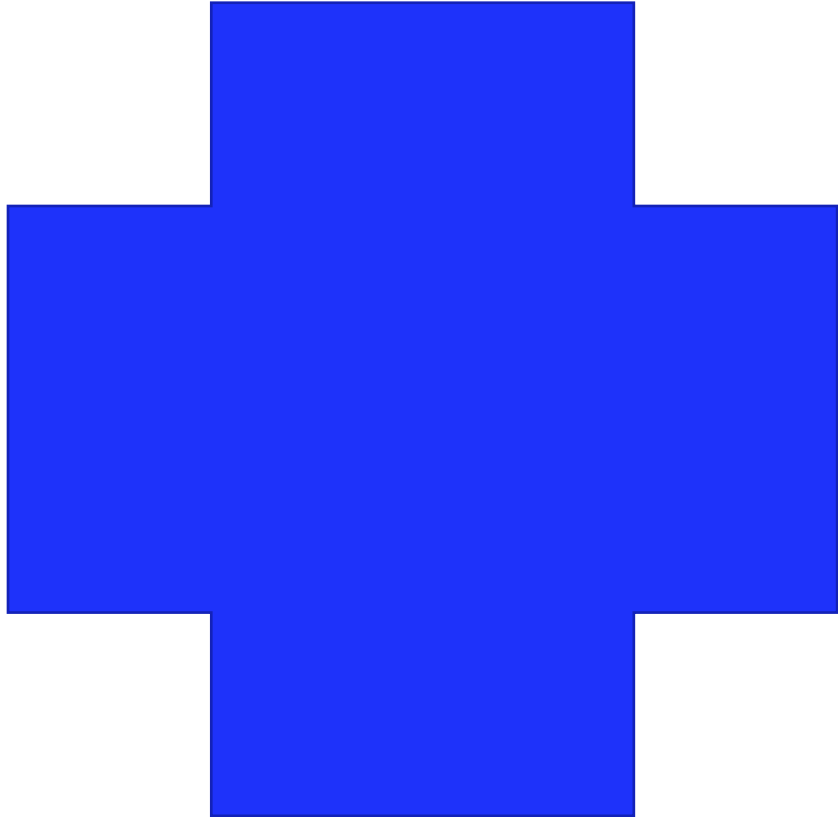
- For governments to reopen borders they need to trust a passenger COVID-19 test or vaccine status
- This is achieved through linking a passenger's verified digital ID to their test or vaccine certificate.
- ICAO Digital Travel Credential standards should be used to create a digital passport



Linking with travel processes current and future

- Integration into airlines' own apps for a more seamless journey for travelers
- Support pre-processing
- Contactless travel
