I wish to invite your Administration/Organization to attend the *ICAO Aviation Data and Analysis dashboards workshop for SAM Region*, hosted by the ICAO South American (SAM) Regional Office, to be carried out in Lima, Peru from 12 to 13 December 2022.

The objective of the workshop is to bring together national stakeholders (Regulators, Air Navigation Service Providers - ANSPs, Aerodrome Operators, Aircraft Operators) to review and gather feedback on the ICAO dashboards which are part of the digital transformation and the implementation of electronic data management and business intelligence project of the Organization, which has developed advanced dashboards for monitoring and assessing key trends in air transport. The ICAO dashboards encompass a wide array of analytics ranging from operations to financials, including evolution of passenger and cargo traffic, aircraft fleet usage, traffic by Flight Information Region (FIR), and revenue impact on airlines, airports and air navigation services providers (ANSPs).

Likewise, they allow for easy visualization, comparison and analysis at different levels of granularity, i.e. by State, region, route group, etc. Information contained in the dashboards are continuously updated and can be downloaded for further analysis as per the needs of each Member State. These dashboards are designed to provide States with detailed insights into the aviation industry, and serve as powerful support tools for enhanced data processing and visualization.

The provisional agenda will cover a presentation of ICAO Big Data analytics using Tableau dashboards to monitor the State of the Industry and COVID-19 pandemic related economic and operational impacts by the Aviation Data and Analysis Office/ATB/ICAO and an exchange experiences and impressions regarding the new tool in order to improve it for a more adequate and personalized use by the States.


Taking into consideration the scope of the subjects to be addressed by the workshop, it is strongly recommended that your delegation includes experts from both the regulator and air navigation service providers' side, who are actively involved in the economic planning, analysis and policy making, as well as extend the invitation to airport and heliport operators.

Please consider that the event will be held in English, with simultaneous interpretation services.
