The objective of the course is to train the maintenance personnel of the REDDIG II nodes, which have links to the two segments of REDDIG II (satellite and terrestrial), to familiarize themselves with the available functionalities and configuration of the acquired equipment.

The training will be delivered in Spanish and will have an English interpretation service. The mnemotecnic paper is included as **Attachment B** and the documentation, syllabus as well as course material will be published on the ICAO SAM Regional Office website:
