1. Introduction

1.1 ICAO Doc 7383 contains all aeronautical information provided by States, as well as the points of contact and location of NOF offices.

1.2 The constant review and updating of this information will help the user to simplify procedures for obtaining aeronautical information vital to the planning and development of air operations.

2. Discussion

2.1 This document has been developed by ICAO to inform users and stakeholders about the aeronautical information available in States.

2.2 The Meeting will note that Parts 1 and 2 of the cited document describe in detail the aeronautical information services provided by States. Both are published pursuant to Recommendation 27 of the First Conference of the Aeronautical Information Services Department.

2.3 Part 1 provides essential data about the type of aeronautical information available from the various States and how to obtain it. The tables are supplemented by a map showing the geographical area for which each service is responsible.

2.4 Part 2 describes the current exchange of NOTAM messages between NOTAM offices. Page 0-5 states that ICAO (HQ and Regional Offices) needs to be aware of aeronautical information published by States.

2.5 Documents equivalent to NOTAMs, aeronautical information publications or aeronautical information circulars should be provided in the same quantity as indicated for the equivalent document.

2.6 This document also contains, in Part 3, a list of international airports, including those designated in accordance with Article 10 of the Convention on International Civil Aviation.

2.7 The Meeting may note that the current document published on the ICAO website dates back to 2014.

2.8 The Meeting may wish to urge States to review the content of the Document, and update it as needed, through letter to ICAO, no later than 28 February 2023.

3. Suggested action

3.1. The Meeting is invited to:

- a) take note of the information provided in this working paper;
- b) support the action recommended in item 2.8; and
- c) consider other actions as it may deem appropriate.
