EXPLANATORY NOTES OF THE TENTATIVE AGENDA

PRELIMINARY ASYNCHRONOUS SESSION

Agenda Item 1A: Current situation and regional priorities

The Meeting will take note of the air traffic situation and the projection for the coming years regarding the SAM Region, adjusted to the impact of COVID-19.

On the other hand, it will discuss the progress of the implementation of the different plans and initiatives related to ICAO's strategic objectives: Safety, Capacity and Efficiency of Air Navigation, Security and Facilitation, Economic Development and Environmental Protection.

Agenda Item 2A: Follow up to conclusions adopted in previous RAAC meetings

Under this agenda item, the Meeting will review the status of implementation of valid conclusions adopted by previous RAAC meetings.

Agenda Item 3A: Ratification of international air law treaties

Under this agenda item, the Meeting will review the status of ratification of international air law treaties, as well as the benefits and requirements for States to become parties.

Agenda Item 4A: Initiatives for the Development and sustainability of air transport in the Region (Declaration to promote Connectivity through the Development and Sustainability of Air Transport in the Pan American Region – Vision 2020-2035 and goals of the A41)

Under this agenda item, different experiences, lessons learned and best practices on issues related to the implementation of the national framework of aviation planning in relation to the development of the State's Civil Aviation Master Plan will be disseminated to the Meeting. Active participation from the Directors of Civil Aviation is expected to inform on their challenges, lessons learned and achievements through the presentation of working papers.

In addition, the Meeting will be informed on the progress made by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) on the best practices for civil aviation regulators of the States. The progress made in obtaining a connectivity metric for the Region, including the analysis conducted on the status of connectivity will also be presented,.

Agenda Item 5A: Other business

The Meeting will address any other matter not included in the previous agenda items.

FACE-TO-FACE SESSION

Agenda Item 1B: Review of the matters of the asynchronous phase

The Meeting will review a summary of the matters dealt with in the virtual phase, as well as a preliminary report of such phase.

Agenda Item 2B: Regional strategy towards 2035 – Exercise of the Air Transport Strategic Planning for the SAM Region

A strategic exercise will be conducted on the course of the Region, based on a previous exercise carried out with representatives of the SAM States, to determine the priorities, needs and course of regional civil aviation in follow-up to the commitments undertaken.

Agenda Item 3B: Regional strategy towards 2035 - Exercise for the establishment of strategies of the SAM Region with respect to CORSIA and Sustainable Aviation Fuels (SAF)

A space will be opened to share experiences, as well as to carry out a regional exercise on future strategies to face the upcoming challenges to the civil aviation system in South America, related to environmental protection through the adoption of initiatives such as CORSIA and the implementation of sustainable aviation fuels.
