# ORIGEN Y PROGRESO DE LA TAREA



The Departmental Meeting on Meteorology, held in 2014, formulated Recommendation 5/2 requesting that an appropriate ICAO group, in close coordination with the World Meteorological Organization, undertake a restructuring of Annex 3 – Meteorological Service for International Air Navigation, with a view to retaining provisions containing "requirements" in Annex 3 and transferring provisions related to "means of compliance" to new Procedures for Meteorological Services. Air Navigation – Meteorology (PANS MET).

A bilateral meeting between the WMO Secretary-General and the ICAO Secretary-General took place in April 2017. The bilateral meeting concluded, inter alia, that in order to improve efficiency, consideration should be given to the deletion of Document WMO-No. 49, Volume II.

The restructuring of Annex 3 was subsequently carried out by the Meteorological Panel (METP), based on a study carried out by a Consultant, appointed by the ICAO Secretary General.

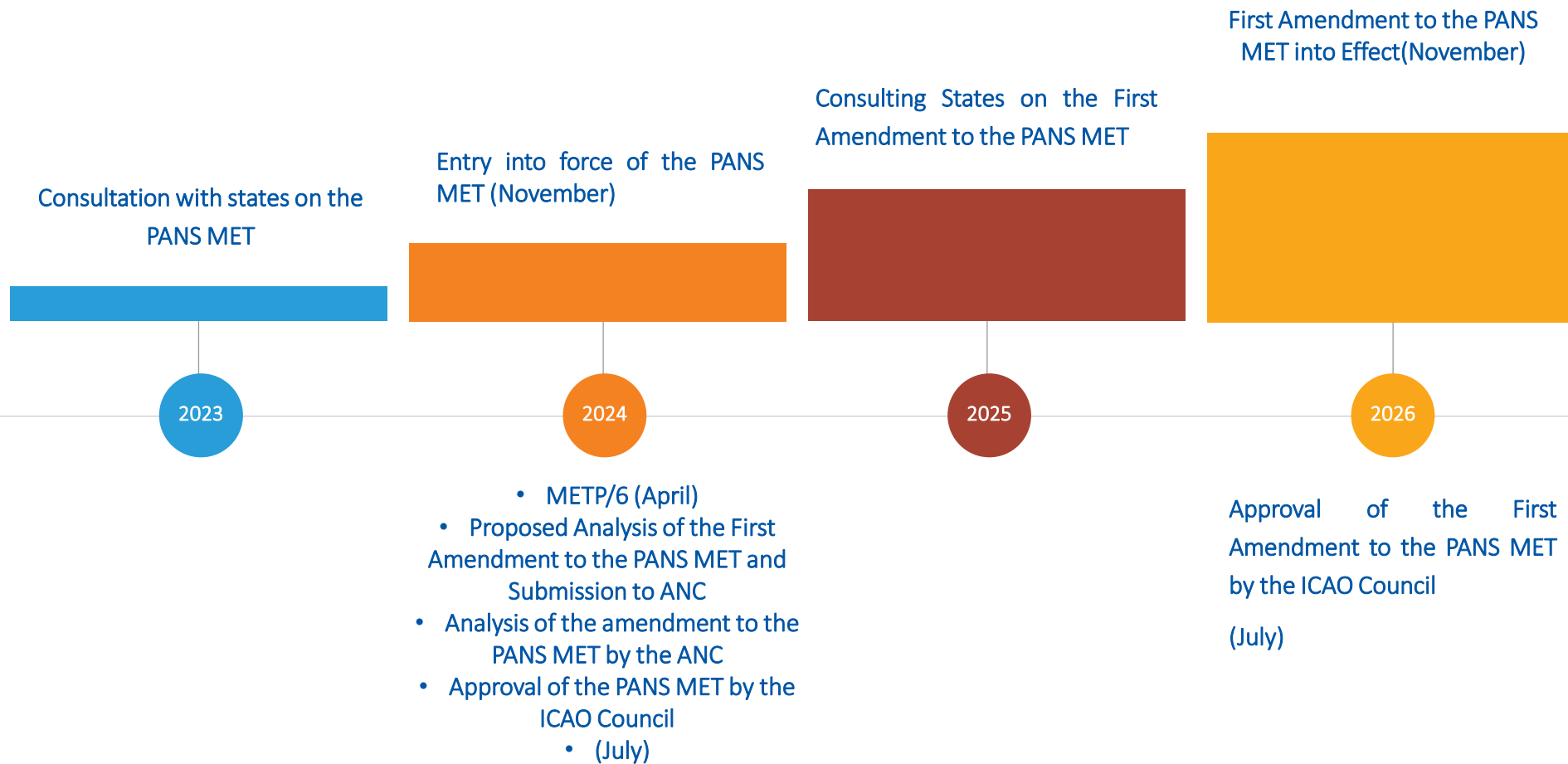
In May/June 2023, the nineteenth World Meteorological Congress (G-19) adopted, through the formulation of Resolution 4.1(3)/1 (Cg-19), the following:

- a) Discontinue WMO-No. 49, Volume II, Part I and Part II with effect from December 31, 2023; and
- b) Discontinue WMO-No. 49, Volume II, Part III and Part IV where material of continuing relevance has been incorporated into the PANS-METs, preferably as part of Amendment 1 (provisionally 2026).

In April 2024, the Sixth Meeting of the ICAO Meteorological Panel will be held, which must be approved:

- a) Aviation Hazardous Weather Information Service (HWIS);
- b) Enhancement of the services provided by global and regional advisory centres;
- c) Impact on ICAO Guidance Documents of the Enhanced Definition of Meteorological Authority; and
- d) Other issues of interest that may arise for your consideration as a result of the work of your groups and streams of work.
