#### **CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

1. The SAM Region should observe the Contingency Plans of the different ANS areas and insert it into the ATS Framework Contingency Plan.
2. The SAM Region should review the Volcanic Ash Contingency Plan and update it to the latest amendments of the ICAO Annexes and Documents.
3. The SAM Region should work on the preparation of the Radioactive Material Release Contingency Plan, and involve the AIS/AIM, MET and ATS areas in this Plan.
4. The SAM Region should disseminate the responsibilities of the different areas of Air Navigation involved in a Contingency Plan for Release of Radioactive Material.
5. The SAM Region should disseminate the ICAO recommendations related to Cybersecurity for ANS systems to be resilient.
6. The SAM Region should promote the culture of cybersecurity as automation is implemented in ANS services.
7. The SAM Region should work on preparing and conducting an exercise on volcanic ash that includes the involvement of all ANS areas as well as industry. This exercise should be developed every two years.
