3. Registration and opening ceremony

Participant registration for all events will be at 8:30 on November 21, 22 and 23, respectively. It is kindly requested that a passport or valid identification be shown for this purpose.

For security reasons, participants are requested to carry the identification of the event, that will be provided when registered, while in the Hotel premises and during these activities are carried out.

The schedule of these events will be from 9:00 AM to 04:30 PM, in official time of Brazil.

4. Working language

The workshops and the meeting will be conducted in Spanish with interpretation services in English.

5. Event fee

The workshop and the meeting are free of charge.

6. Relevant information of Foz do Iguaçu

a) Weather

The average temperature in Foz do Iguacu in November, for a typical day, ranges from a high of 87°F (31°C) and a low of 68°F (20°C). Some would describe it as pleasantly warm humid but cool.

b) Local currency and credit cards

The Brazilian Real (R\$) is the national currency. Exchange rate on October 12th 2022 was USD 1 = R\$ 5,29. For updated money exchange values please visit: <https://www.bcb.gov.br/estabilidadefinanceira/fechamentodolar>

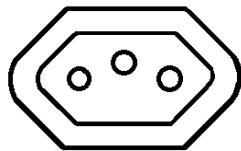
Money exchange must always be done at local banks at the airport or hotels authorized by the Central Bank. American Express, MasterCard, and Visa credit cards are accepted by most banks, shops, and tourist facilities. ATMs machines accept debit and credit cards.

c) Commercial working hours and banking schedules

Commercial working hours in the city are mostly from 8AM to 6PM in a business week, and up to 1PM on Saturdays. Big malls are open from 10AM to 10PM, and from 11AM to 9PM on Sundays. Restaurants working hours vary, but usually are open until 11PM.

d) Type of outlet and voltage in Foz do Iguaçu

The sockets compatible with the Brazilian ones correspond to the NBR 14136 standard, which have three pins, suitable for devices that require grounding.



It is recommended to use the universal plug adapter while the stay in Brazil.

In Brazil some states are 110V and others 220V, it is necessary to be careful with the voltage of the installation and appliances, since the Brazilian standard sockets are not identified for this. In Foz do Iguaçu the electrical voltage is 110 V, although it is common to find establishments with dual voltage.

7. Medical coverage

Please be advised that your nominees should be medically fit and should have either medical insurance or other medical coverage to meet expenses, if any, towards illness or medical emergency during the above event. ICAO nor the host State will take responsibility to meet expenses in this regard. A repatriation medical insurance is highly recommended. Bottled water is also highly recommended.

The emergency number in Foz do Iguaçu is 190 for police, 192 for ambulance, and 193 for Fire Department.
