 - Establish a body (POC) in the region to coordinate the ATN Directory Service with Eurocontrol (Europe/global and with Aero Thai for Asia/Pacific)

 - Update the CNS FASID table to include ATN router bandwidth/network protocol and AMHS implementation
 - Develop routing policy for IP
 - Develop MTA routing policy
