1.1 The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has hosted the holding of the Eighth Meeting of the Global Aeronautical Information Management Consortium, held in Orlando, Florida, USA, in March 2009.

2.1 The mentioned meeting was attended by 20 delegates from the following States and International Organizations: Australia, Canada, China, United States, ICAO, Jamaica, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

2.2 The working agenda for the three days meeting contemplated a revision of events carried out within the framework of ICAO through the AIS-AIM Study Group; CANSO Study Group and the Seminar on global ATC held in Amsterdam; Fourth Annual AIXM Conference (Washington), Revision of the Conclusions of the Global Congress (2006); Review of the results of the Congress held in Singapore (2008); Planning of Congresses foreseen to be held in South Africa, and the Global Congress, foreseen to be held in China in 2010, as well as on Digital NOTAM; AIXM, Next Generation; e-Tod, and presentation of related technical matters.
