1. Introduction

1.1 The ICAO requirements on language proficiency establish that the AIS/MAP personnel should have the skill to write, speak and understand the technical English language, in compliance with the current requirements in Annex 15 paragraph 3.6.1, Operational Level 4, for the application in each element of the Integrated Aeronautical Information Package (IAIP).

2. Discussion

2.1 To develop this task and considering the contents of the documentation available, the AIM/TRAIN/TF/10 deemed convenient to recommend that the AIM Subgroup propose the application of guidance and training programmes for the AIM personnel in the English language contained in the ICAO Doc. 9835 AN/453.

2.2 In accordance with the above, States should apply the language proficiency rating scales established to develop effective and efficient programmes for the AIM personnel, considering the responsibility in the application of the English language in the Integrated Aeronautical Information Package as established in Annex 15.

2.3 Based in the mentioned above, the Training Task Force agreed to present to the AIM Subgroup, the following draft conclusion:

Apply Doc. 9835 AN/453 – “*Manual on the Implementation of ICAO Language Proficiency Requirements*”, as the main reference for the formulation of their English language training programmes, adapting whatever necessary in accordance with the AIM (AIS/MAP) personnel functions performance requirements, in support to the Global ATM Operational Plan.
