Sir:

I have the honour to refer to my communication LT 2/8.11.10 - LT 2/8.16.8/SA093 dated 8 February 2010, inviting you to attend the above-mentioned Meetings.

In this respect, and as indicated in paragraph 3.6.6 of Agenda Item 3 of the Final Report of the GREPECAS/15, it was noted that in order to activate the mechanism of the new subgroup, “at least two meetings would be needed before GREPECAS/16, one to develop the work programmes and to identify the task forces that would be required, and the other to monitor and make operational adjustments to the work programme established at its first meeting”.

Based on the above and taking into account the issues of most importance, the second Meeting of CNS/ATM/SG will be held in November this year. After examining the results by the CNS/ATM/SG/2, we would be able to hold meetings of the ACG / 8 and ASB/10. In this regard, let me inform you that, following

coordination with the President of GREPECAS, it was considered that both meetings, the ACG/8 and ASB/10 be postponed until early 2011. On the other hand, the GREPECAS/16 meeting may be convened by March next year.

I take this opportunity to reiterate the assurances of my highest consideration.
