Information highlighting your State's relationship with ICAO, such as (where applicable): year of joining ICAO; year elected to the ICAO Council; permanent representation in ICAO Headquarters; representative of Regional Bodies to ICAO; and any other item deemed of interest.

3 HISTORICAL FOOTNOTE

A prominent date or event, with details, you wish to highlight as a milestone in the history of civil aviation in your State.
