

Dear Dr. Liu,

With reference to your letter AS8/5-18/17 we would like to inform you that Georgia developed and implemented changes in the following laws:

- The Air Code of Georgia (Article 42, para 2 – adopted in 11 December of 2015), where the prohibited areas of lasers use are given;
- Code of Administrative Offences of Georgia (Article 108, para 1 - adopted in 11 December of 2015), where a penalty sanctions of using lasers in the prohibited areas is specified.

Detection and penetration of the offenses are made by the Patrol Police Department. In addition, by the Order no.17 of the Director of the Civil Aviation Agency, dated 5th of February 2014, "Occurrence Reporting Rule" was established, which gives the opportunity of collecting and analyzing the reports about lasers interferences.
