Following progress is what Sweden has made to curb the number of perpetrations of laser illumination.

- a) An information video has been broadcast on Swedish public TV in regard to the use and the danger of powerful handheld laser devices. There is a link on our home page (Transportstyrelsen) to the Swedish Radiation Safety Agency's information about powerful handheld laser devices. Information has also been sent to the Swedish AOC holders about laser illumination and the recommended actions the crews should take when they are under a laser attack.
- b) Some cases of laser illumination of aircraft have been prosecuted under the new law. Breach of the law could render a fine or imprisonment up to two years.
- c) the new law was adopted January 1, 2014 by the Swedish parliament, which makes it illegal to manufacture, import to Sweden, use, own, sell, or distribute powerful handheld laser device (3R, 3B and 4) without a permit from the Swedish Radiation Safety Authority.
