1. Introduction

1.1 This paper presents the adjustments of actual costs and actual cost shares for the period 1 January to 31 December 2010.

2. Actual Costs for the Period 1 January to 31 December 2010

2.1 Table 1 below presents a summary of the actual SADIS costs for the period 1 January to 31 December 2010. Details of these costs are included in SCRAG/12-WP/5.

3. Cost Shares for the Period 1 January to 31 December 2010

- 3.1 Two States, Morocco and the Russian Federation, which were not assessed for the year 2010 by the SCRAG/10 Meeting, have had the service withdrawn respectively on 6 August 2002 and 8 November 2006 but reinstated respectively on 1 July 2010 and 7 October 2010. Consequently, their share of the actual costs for 2010 was calculated based respectively on 6 and 2 full months of service in 2010.
- 3.2 One State, Namibia, which was not assessed for the year 2010 by the SCRAG/10 Meeting, is included in the calculation of the actual cost shares for 2010 considering that it receives the SADIS service since 1 July 2010. Consequently, its share of the actual costs for 2010 was calculated based on 6 full months of service in 2010.
- 3.3 Taking into account the information in Table 1 and paragraphs 3.1 and 3.2 above, the Attachment shows, for the period 1 January to 31 December 2010, the actual cost share to be borne by each State receiving the SADIS service, based on the 2010 available tonne-kilometers in scheduled services (ATKs), in accordance with Article XI, paragraph 3 of the SADIS Agreement.

4. **Action by the Group**

- 4.1 The Group is invited to:
 - a) review the actual costs of providing the SADIS services for the period 1 January to 31 December 2010 totaling £843 740, presented in Table 1 above;
 - b) note the information presented in paragraphs 3.1 to 3.3 above; and
 - c) determine the cost share for the period 1 January to 31 December 2010 to be borne by the States participating in the SCAR scheme in 2010 on the basis of their number of ATKs for 2010, as presented in the Attachment.

Note 1: Considering that the service to Morocco and the Russian Federation had been withdrawn respectively on 6 August 2002 and 8 November 2006 and reinstated respectively on 1 July 2010 and 7 October 2010, their share of the 2010 actual costs was calculated based respectively on 6 and 2 full months of service in 2010.

Note 2: Considering that Namibia receives the service since 1 July 2010, its share of the 2010 actual costs was calculated based on 6 full months of service in 2010.

Note 3: The number of ATKs for Cameroon is nil in 2010 since its only airline ceased operating in March 2008. We did not receive the number of ATKs in 2010 for Congo, Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana and Senegal. The number of ATKs shown is that of 2008 for the first four States and 2009 for the last State adjusted based on the growth rate of ATKs for Africa of -1.7% in 2009 and 17.2% in 2010.
