I wish to invite your Administration to participate in the Radio Navigation Workshop for the NAM/CAR/SAM Regions, to be held at the ICAO SAM Regional Office in Lima, Peru, from 2 to 4 September 2026.

The Workshop aims to provide a forum to discuss challenges and exchange best practices related to Global Navigation Satellite System radio frequency interference (GNSS-RFI), including its impacts and the mitigation strategies adopted by the different stakeholders. The Workshop will also provide updated information on the latest developments in the field of radio navigation aids involving GNSS constellations and augmentation systems. In addition, the Workshop will address key aspects related to radio navigation flight inspection.

Representatives from the States and Territories of the ICAO NAM/CAR/SAM Regions, as well as international organizations and industry representatives, are expected to attend. States/Territories and Organizations are invited to provide information regarding the status of implementation and operation of their air navigation aids.

The working languages of the meeting will be English and Spanish, and simultaneous interpretation will be provided if a sufficient number of participants from both language groups register in a timely manner. The Nemetecnic Paper containing general information is provided in **Appendix A**, and the tentative programme of the event is provided in **Appendix B**.
