- **Opening**

Interactive roundtable discussions by Ministers, setting the stage to discuss key policies to aid aviation recovery and set resilience, and set guidelines for the two working streams

- **Closing**

Adoption of the declarations

Technical Streams

- **Safety**

Elevation of **technologies, business models and training approaches to attract next generation**

- **Facilitation**

Deal with **consolidated reports received from States; uncovering three major accesses i.e. harmonization of health measures at the borders, use of technology in development of digital solutions, and overcoming the short-term and long-term challengers** like the set of multi-layer risk mitigations strategies

 - ✓ High-level technical advisors on aviation safety, security, facilitation, economic, financial and public health
- **Council guests** with observer status

- c) Declaration of the Conference, which will be adopted at the closing Ministerial Plenary.
