What is the IAASM?

- International Academy of Aviation and Space Medicine Inc.
 - = 'IAASM Inc.'
 - = 'The International Academy'
 - = 'The Academy'
- founded 1955
- non-profit organisation, voluntary, funded mainly by dues and donations
- recognised by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) as an 'International Non-Governmental Organization'
- membership organisation: elected membership based on outstanding contribution to Aviation and Space Medicine (max 275)
- incorporated in New Zealand



Membership Categories

- Full (Academician)/10 years minimum ASM
 - voting rights and committee activities
- Associate Member / 5 years minimum ASM
- Corporate Member
 - For organisations with an interest in aviation safety, ASM education and philanthropy eg Aviation Medicine Institutes, Aviation Authorities (civil and military), aviation medicine-related businesses

Also Affiliate (non-membership) - young doctors or scientists

- senior doctor, less experience in Av Med

- Registered in New Zealand
- Funds Scholarship Awards for ASM Specialty training
- Currently 4 Trustees Chaired by a NZ IAASM Director, plus 2 more in NZ plus IAASM Sec Gen (USA)

Solomon Beka – Ethiopia

- 2021 Scholar
- PhD: 'Flight safety risk mitigation strategies for longterm neurocognitive effects of Covid-19 in airline pilots'
- His research has identified tests for assessing a pilot's neurocognitive function post-Covid-19, to detect potential neurocognitive impairments.
- Graduated 10 May 2025
