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STRUCTURE/MEMBERSHIP

- CASP-AP IS DIRECTED BY ANNUAL STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING, ROTATING CHAIRMAN
 - Presently Singapore, SCM - 14 members, 4 partners
 - Programme Coordinator (PC) and Technical Assistant (TA) manage the Programme, coordinating with Chairman/RO, between Steering Committee meetings
- CASP-AP MEMBERSHIP REMAINS AT 24 (22/2)
 - Around three quarters of these are quite involved with CASP-AP in varying ways
 - Some member States have limited or no involvement and gain no benefits



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ROLE AND DIRECTIONS

- ENHANCE SECURITY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF MEMBERS AND THEREFORE THE REGION
- INCREASE COMMUNICATION AND HARMONISATION BETWEEN MEMBERS
- ASSIST MEMBERS TO MEET INTERNATIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE CONVENTION, INSTRUMENTS AND ANNEXES 9 AND 17.
- CASP-AP MODEL NOW BEING DUPLICATED IN MIDDLE EAST



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CASP-AP TASKS

- ASSIST MEMBERS TO RECTIFY ISSUES EITHER FROM USAP OR OTHER ISSUES
- SPECIFIC ASSISTANCE FOR EACH MEMBER
- PROVIDE 'MODEL' PROGS AND DOCUMENTS
 - Major upgrade task underway for these
- PROVIDE TRAINING AND MENTORING
- ANNUAL WORK PLAN APPROVED BY SCM INCLUDES ALL IDENTIFIED TASKS
- MEMBERS SHOW CLEAR IMPROVEMENTS

- Sub-Regional approach
- Phased approach to implementation

- Emphasis on training and capacity building



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TRAINING /CAPACITY BUILDING

- AWP 2013/14 HAS LIMITED PROGRAMME WORK AND MORE TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING
 - CONCENTRATES ON CERTAIN CRITICAL ELEMENTS (CEs 7, 8, 5 AND 4)
 - USE OF SUB-REGIONAL APPROACH
 - COMPLETING THREE PHASED IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT (3-4 SA States) WILL BE SIGNIFICANT
 - NEXT USE SAME APPROACH FOR 3-4 SEA STATES
 - CHANCE FOR MORE PARTNERING AND MENTORING SUPPORT, MEMBERS/PARTNERS



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PHASE III 2014-2019

- **CASP-AP WILL COMPLETE PHASE II IN JUNE 2014 AND MOVE TO PHASE III IN JULY. PHASE III WILL :**
- refine objectives to best serve the needs of members, including a 'vision' to tightly focus the organization
- remove objective of 'creating An AvSec regional structure'
- use existing four tiered members' financial contribution system, based on World Bank economic formula
- concentrate on training and capacity building for members
- reduce costs using 'regional' experts and support in-kind from members/partners and will look for donor support
