Subject: First Meeting of the Asia Pacific Regional Aviation Safety Team (APRAST/1), 20 to 24 February 2012. Parallels Theiland

Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to invite you to the First Meeting of the Asia Pacific Regional Aviation Safety Team (APRAST/I) from 20 to 24 February 2012 at the ICAO Asia Pacific Office, Bangkok.

Kindly recall that at the First Meeting of the Regional Aviation Safety Group – Asia Pacific (RASG-APAC/1) in New Caledonia from 10-11 October 2011, the meeting adopted the organizational structure and terms-of-reference including the Asia Pacific Regional Aviation Safety Team and its ad hoc Working Groups, i.e. the APRAST Accident Investigation ad hoc Working Group (APRAST-AIG AWG) and the APRAST Safety Reporting and Programme ad hoc Working Group (APRAST-SRP AWG). The organizational structure and the terms-of-reference of the APRAST and its contributory bodies are attached for ease of reference, **Attachment A**.

You may also recall that the three Asia COSCAP safety teams had since been combined to form the Asia Regional Aviation Safety Team (ARAST) to improve efficiency, reduce duplication of effort and provide a wider forum for the exchange of best safety practices. The ARAST has now transitioned into the APRAST to include all States/Administrations in the Asia and Pacific regions.

The APRAST/1 meeting is open to all States/Administrations in the Asia and Pacific regions and Industry Partners of the RASG-APAC. Membership of the APRAST includes the regulatory authority (flight operations, airworthiness and air traffic management representatives), air operators, service providers, manufacturers and industry organizations. Recognizing that the industry input is important in developing meaningful safety enhancements, the regulatory authorities are requested to kindly extend an invitation to their air operators and service providers as considered appropriate. It is important for the States/Administrations to have a broad participation at the meeting. Continuity of the Team Members and their regular participation at the APRAST meeting is important to ensure thorough discussions and timely action on implementation of the recommend actions.

I would like to take this opportunity to also thank the donor partners, aircraft manufacturers and the international organizations for their unfaltering support to ICAO and in particular the COSCAPs and the ARAST. We look forward to your continued cooperation and meaningful support to the APRAST as well.

In pursuance of the decision taken at the RASG-APAC/1 meeting, at the First Meeting of the Asia Pacific Regional Aviation Safety Team (APRAST/1), it is intended to elect the Co-chairs for the safety team from the nominated members. One Co-chair will be elected from a Contracting State and the other Co-chair from the industry. The APRAST Co-chairs will facilitate the proceedings of the meeting and encourage sharing of safety information and experiences among all stakeholders. It is also intended to initiate the establishment of the two ad hoc working groups (APRAST-AIG AWG and APRAST-SRP AWG) by electing a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson each, from the nominated members from the participating States/Administrations.

At the APRAST/1 meeting we intend to pick up the thread from the work already done by the COSCAPs'ARAST. In one of its earlier meetings, the ARAST during its review of GASP/R implementation, considered the implementation of the ICAO standards for a State Safety Programme (SSP) and concluded that the implementation of an SSP would address, in an orderly manner/approach, the global safety initiatives and best practices of the GASP/R. In order for the APAC Office and the APRAST to establish priority and support activities, Member States/Administrations are invited to complete a preliminary gap analysis for review by the APAC Office. I would request you to send us the filled up forms at **Attachment B** at your earliest convenience so that the overall regional implementation status can be reviewed at the 1st APRAST meeting. Member-specific information will, of course, remain confidential and will not be disclosed at the meeting.

The Tentative/Provisional Agenda for the meeting is at **Attachment C.** To facilitate this Office to make appropriate preparations for the meeting, I would appreciate receiving from you the following via e-mail at <u>icao apac@bangkok.icao.int</u> or fax +66 (2) 537-8199:

- a) any suggestion for additions/changes to the Tentative/Provisional Agenda of the meeting, keeping in view the Terms-of-Reference attached;
- b) the name, position and address of all attendees using the Nomination form provided at **Attachment D**; and
- c) the titles of any working/information papers your Administration intends to submit in accordance with the Tentative/Provisional Agenda. Kindly note in this regard that electronic copy of the papers in MS word format should be sent to this Office at your earliest convenience, by e mail to icao_apac@bangkok.icao.int preferably not later than 20 January 2012.

The documents for the 1st APRAST meeting are available on the ICAO APAC website http://www.bangkok.icao.int/ under Regional Aviation Safety Group (RASG). A more detailed Agenda with supporting documentation will be made available to you on the APAC website at least two weeks before the meeting.

Participants are advised that ICAO is moving towards a 'paperless' meeting environment by the increasing use of electronic media for the distribution of meeting materials. In this context, all meeting working/information papers will be made available in soft copy. Meeting participants are encouraged to take advantage of the wireless network facility available in the meeting venue. A portable computer equipped with Wi-Fi networking capability is required.

A bulletin containing the details on the venue of the meeting, useful travel information and other information of interest to participants is at **Attachment E**.

I would be grateful to receive your confirmation on the participation of your Administration/Organization at the meeting, in addition to the information requested in sub-paragraphs a), b) and c) above at the earliest, but preferably not later than **20 January 2012**.
