END-USER ECCAIRS TRAINING

SUMMARY

This paper discusses the provision of end-user ECCAIRS training by Singapore.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 At the 3rd meeting of the Accident Investigation Ad hoc Working Group of the Asia Pacific Regional Aviation Safety Team (APRAST-AIG AWG/3), it was recommended in Conclusion 3/3 that Singapore explore the possibility of conducting ECCAIRS training.
- 1.2 This paper discusses a recent end-user ECCAIRS training conducted by Singapore, which was attended by Cambodia.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 On 25-26 July 2013, Singapore conducted an end-user ECCAIRS training. It was attended by two Cambodian representatives and staff of the AAIB Singapore.
- 2.2 The objective of the training was to allow users to be capable of filing an Accident/ Incident Data Reporting System (ADREP) through the ECCAIRS software.
- 2.3 The training syllabus included:
 - Introduction to the ADREP
 - Manual ADREP reporting exercise based on ADREP 1987 and ADREP 2000.
 - Introduction to ECCAIRS release 4.
 - Electronic ADREP reporting exercise using ECCAIRS release 4.
- 2.4 Cambodia is grateful that Singapore provided this training at no cost. Cambodia has benefited greatly from the course and is confident of preparing an ADREP using ECCAIRS 4.

2.5 In line with the terms of reference of the APAC-AIG, Singapore is keen to conduct the end-user ECCAIRS training for States/ Administrations in the APAC region.
