SUMMARY

This paper summarises the responses of APAC States/Administrations to a survey conducted by the ICAO APAC Office with a view to ascertaining the assistance and training needs of the APAC States/Administrations, so as to facilitate the APAC-AIG in identifying priorities and developing action plan in areas where assistance is most needed.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 At the request of the APRAST-AIG AWG, the ICAO APAC Office conducted a survey with States/Administrations via ICAO APAC State Letter dated 4 March 2013 [Ref: T 10/8.3 – AP031/13 (FS)] on the types of assistance and training which States/Administrations would need to facilitate the setting up or to enhance the operations and capabilities of an independent investigation system.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 To date, 11 States/Administrations have provided their responses to the survey. They are Bangladesh, Hong Kong China, Macao China, DPR of Korea, Japan, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Republic of Korea, Samoa, Singapore and Thailand.

2.2 A summary of the responses on the need for assistance is as follows:
