PROPOSAL FOR APAC-AIG WORK PLAN

SUMMARY

This paper proposes the work plan for the APAC-AIG.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 With the formation of the Asia Pacific Accident Investigation Group (APAC-AIG), this permanent group shall endeavour to fulfil the terms of reference which are:

- To assist States/Administrations in keeping abreast of developments in the area of accident/incident investigation
- To enhance the capabilities and professionalism of the accident/incident investigation bodies
- To promote the sharing of expertise, experience and information among accident/incident investigation bodies
- To develop and strengthen cooperation among the accident/incident investigation bodies

1.2 It is vital that States/Administrations are aware of the accident/incident investigation related activities/events held in the region. In line with the terms of reference, States/Administrations will then be able to consider organising or participating in these activities/events, taking into consideration their individual organisation's commitment.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 A proposed five year work plan is in **Attachment A**. It includes the dates of the upcoming events and the organising States/Administrations.

2.2 It is proposed that the APAC-AIG meetings, ICAO Regional Workshops and Asia SASI Workshops shall be held at least once a year. These are reflected in the proposed work plan.

3. ACTION BY THE MEETING

3.1 The meeting is invited to:

- a) Note the upcoming events that have been planned and consider participating in them;
- b) Encourage States/Administrations to consider hosting the upcoming APAC-AIG meetings, ICAO Regional Workshops and Asia SASI Workshops; and
- c) Encourage States/Administrations to consider organising accident/incident investigation related training activities, taking into consideration the earlier discussion on Sharing of Training Opportunities for Enhancement of Investigation Capabilities¹.
