1. INTRODUCTION

On Oct. 25, 2013 an Intergovernmental Agreement on Civil Aircraft Search and Rescue between Government of Mongolia and Government of Peoples Republic of China was signed by Gansukh A, Mongolian Minister for Road and Transportation and Li Jiexiang, Chief of Civil Aviation Administration of China.

The intergovernmental agreement aims at strengthening cooperation on the regulation of civil aircraft search and rescue between China and Mongolia, setting up a mechanism for information exchange and coordination. The agreement recognizes mutual support between the two countries to provide effective and efficient search and rescue in aviation disasters.
