• Paragraph 3.2 to be inserted in to Annex 13:

"States shall establish an accident investigation authority that is independent from State aviation authorities and other entities that could interfere with the conduct or objectivity of an investigation proposed." ICAO SL 2013/55 dated 19 July 2013 [Ref. AN 6/12-13/55]
