Global Aircraft Tracking Initiatives

 A concept of operations to support future development of a Global Aeronautical Distress and Safety System (GADSS)



Risk to Civil Aviation arising from Conflict Zones

- It is agreed that there is a need for a centralized repository of information provided by States and international organizations.
- The progress of development of an initial prototype centralised capability to support the exchange of available information in support of such risk assessments was reported.



Safety Information Sharing

- The conference acknowledged the benefits and lessons learned from existing information sharing initiatives.
- Recommended to ICAO to develop a global information sharing framework that can be used for different types of information, including the exchange of operational information.



Safety Information Protection

- ICAO updated the progress in the development of new and enhanced provisions related to the protection of certain accident and incident records and other information used to maintain aviation safety and its related sources.
- Recommendations to ICAO:
 - To develop guidance material, tools and seminars tailored to the needs of each region
