 - “How do we do it” requirements
 - Areas that require capacity building
 - Future subject specific workshops (practical)
 - Focus areas for Go-teams
 - Tools/ training/guidance needs
- It is not trying to provide solutions
- Report workshop findings

 - State Safety Programme implementation (SSP)
 - Safety Management System implementation (SMS)
- Roundtable interactive discussion
 - Discuss and identify barriers/obstacles/ challenges
