SUMMARY

This Working Paper invites the APAC Civil Aviation Commission Task Force Expert Group to elect two Coordinators from the experts nominated by the APAC Administrations to organize, coordinate and conduct the meetings.

Action by the Meeting is at Paragraph 3.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The APCACTF agreed on the establishment of an Expert Group comprising the 18 APAC States which participated in the APCACTF/1. The Task Force invited these States to nominate their experts to the Expert Group and noted that at its first meeting, the Expert Group will elect a Coordinator and Vice Coordinator to organize, coordinate and conduct the meetings.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 It is proposed to establish two Expert Groups, one group will examine the Terms of Reference (functions) for the proposed APCAC and the second group will examine other alternatives for strengthening the regional cooperation. The two groups shall be administered by a Coordinator elected from the Experts nominated by the 18 Member States. The Term of the office for the Coordinators will continue until the objectives are realized.

3. ACTION BY THE MEETING

3.1 The Meeting is invited to elect the two Coordinators to organize, coordinate and conduct the meetings of the two groups.

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
