

Governance Plan Improvements from Version 3.0 to Version 5.0

- Clarifications and expansions
 - Eligibility to participate
 - Conditions for suspension or termination
 - ANSP responsibilities
- Reinforcement of key tenets
 - Voluntary program, not to be used for enforcement
 - Coordination with APRAST for mitigation
- Revision to the range of activities and associated costs
 - Alignment of costs and activities to the number of participants
