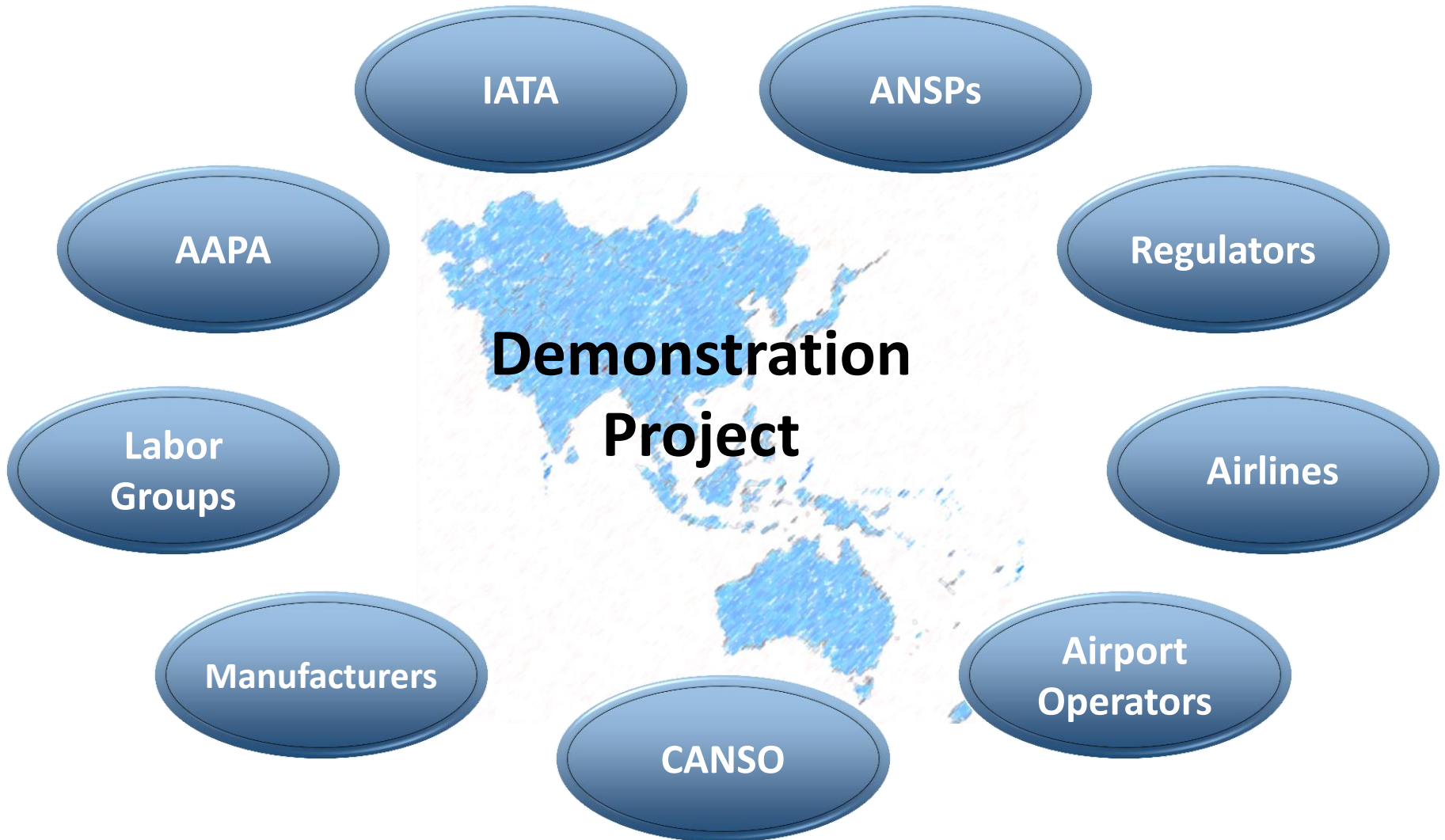

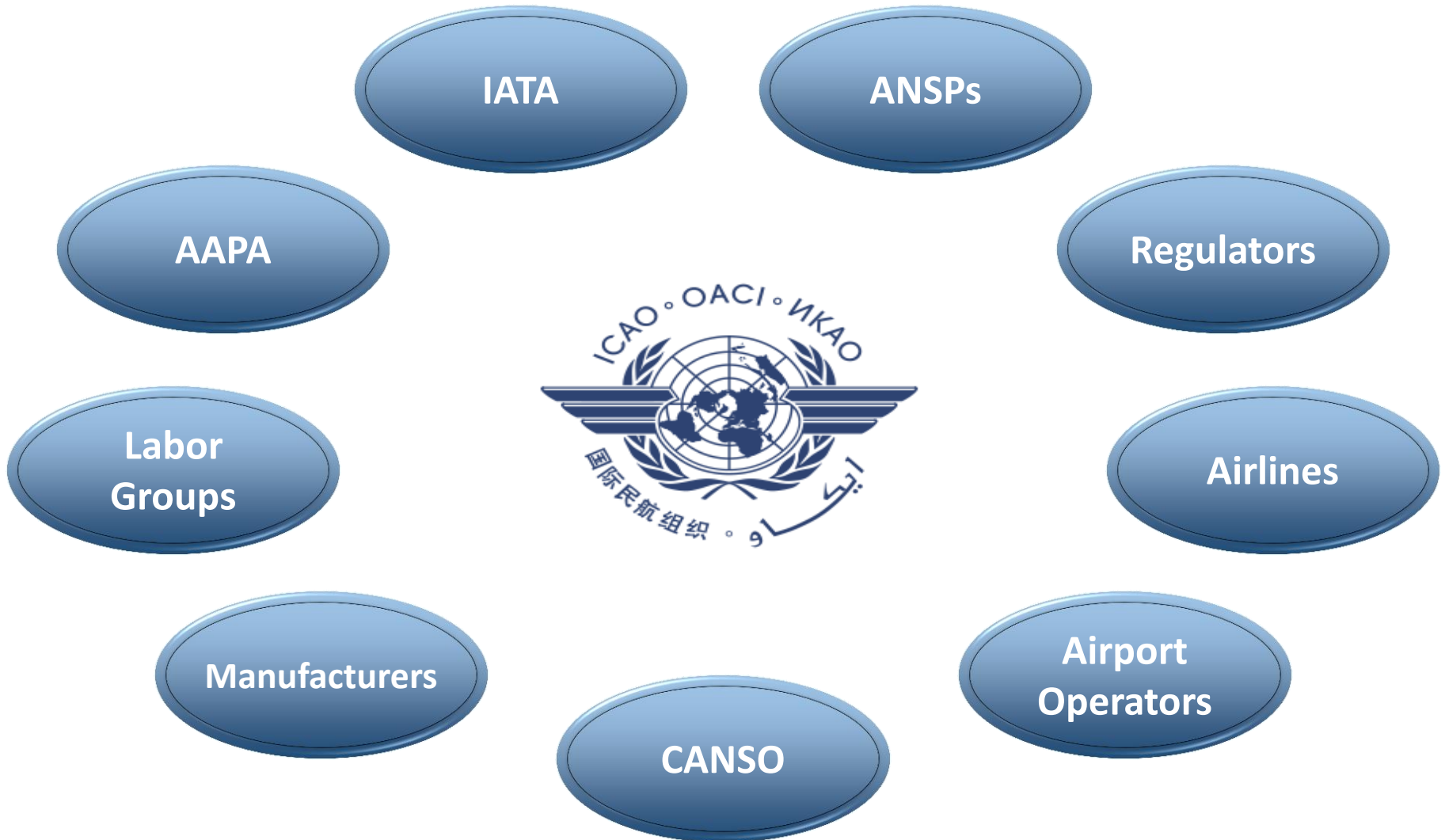

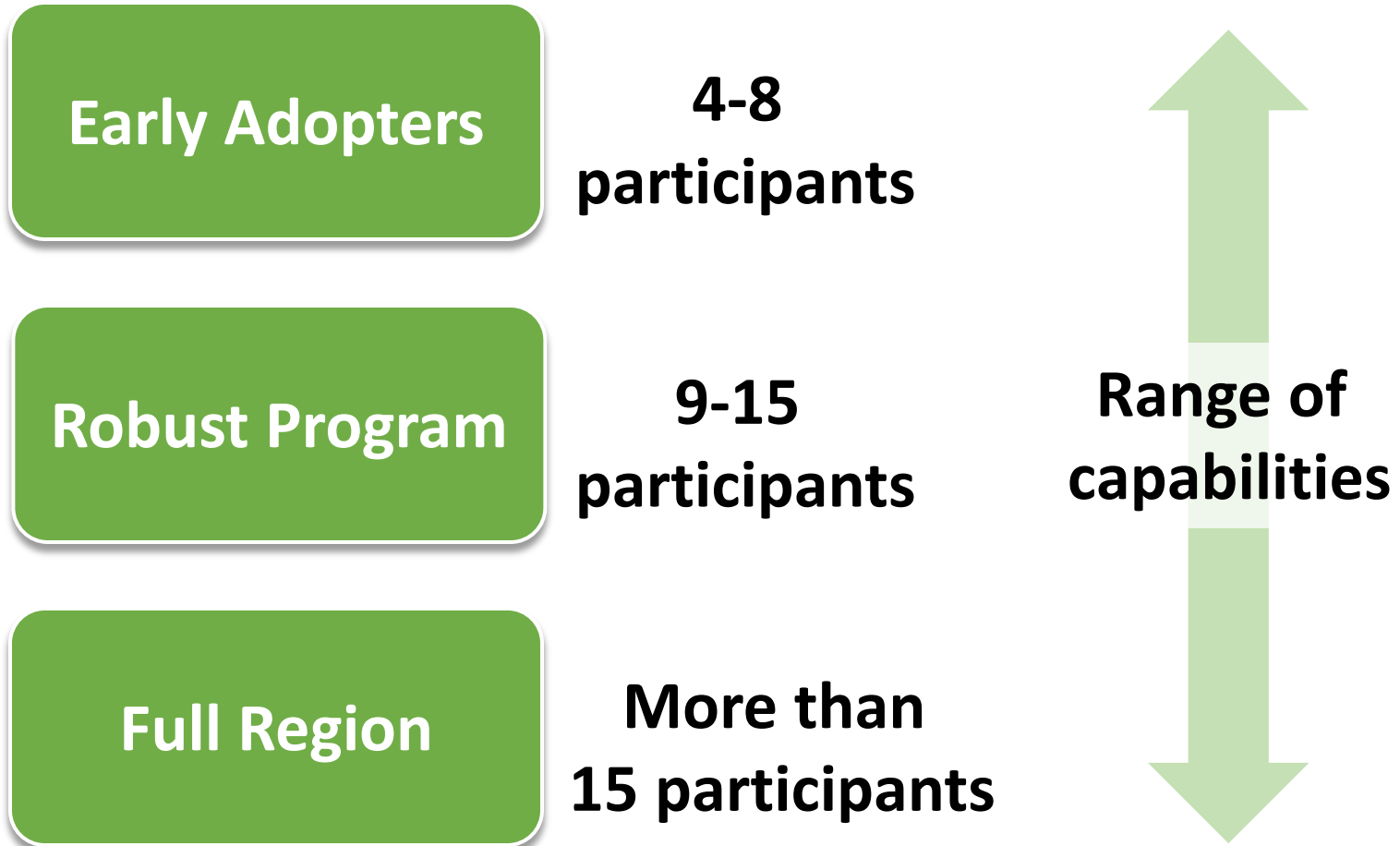

# **Governance Plan Improvements from Version 3.0 to Version 5.0**

- **Clarifications and expansions**
  - **Eligibility to participate**
  - **Conditions for suspension or termination**
  - **ANSP responsibilities**
- **Reinforcement of key tenets**
  - **Voluntary program, not to be used for enforcement**
  - **Coordination with APRAST for mitigation**
- **Revision to the range of activities and associated costs**
  - **Alignment of costs and activities to the number of participants**
