

### **OVERVIEW**

TCB executes ICAO's Technical Co-operation Programme, which provides advice and assistance in the <u>development</u> and <u>implementation</u> of projects across the <u>full spectrum</u> of civil aviation aimed at the <u>safety</u>, <u>security</u>, <u>environmental protection</u> & <u>sustainable development</u> of national and international civil aviation.

#### **TECHNICAL COOPERATION PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION**

#### Technical Assistance

Any assistance provided by ICAO to States, which is funded by the Regular Budget and/or Voluntary Funds, & implemented through any Bureau/Office depending on the nature & duration of the project.

#### **Technical Cooperation**

Any project requested & funded by States and/or organizations & implemented through the Technical Cooperation Bureau on a cost-recovery basis, where all the direct & indirect costs related to the project are recovered.

Since 1952, TCB has implemented projects in excess of US\$ 2 billion

Involved in approximately 140 projects this year



TCB maintains an active roster of over 3000 international experts



#### Roles of ICAO / TCB













- OJT & OPAS (work directly for the government in an executive capacity)




PROCUREMENT


