## Key 2017 AFI Region Goals

80 % of African States to attain 60% EI and above
Zero Significant Safety and Security Concerns
Certification of 45% of International Airports
ANS Targets





### AFI Plan aerodrome certification project

- **Objective**: Certify one international aerodrome in each State
- Launched in August 2016 in Dakar (Senegal) and Nairobi (Kenya)
- Duration: 11 months
- Implementation agencies:

ICAO/States/RSOOs/ACI /AFI-CIS/ ...





### Status of the implementation







#### **Status of the implementation**

- One State on the way to issue the aerodrome certificate
- Six States at the stage of conducting certification inspections
- Twelve States are still implementing their plan of action with very slow progress for few of them



### **States Challenges**

- Documentation to be developed for the aerodrome certification (procedures, manuals, updated aerodrome maps/plans...)
- Poor condition of the pavement, lack of runway strips/RESAs, ...
- Inaccurate visual aids (lighting systems, marking, ...)
- Inadequate RFF services (absence of vehicles, equipment, ...)
- Lack of maintenance of the infrastructure and equipment
- Training / Qualification of Personnel
- Etc.





#### **Other Challenges**

- Lack of adequate commitment of certain CAAs and/or aerodrome Operators
- Lack of adequately trained technical personnel
- Lack of Experts from Donor States/Organizations to support the implementation of the Project



#### Recommendations

- AFI Plan Aerodrome certification project provides assistance to States and is not conducting certification
- CAAs and Airport Operators to reinforce their commitments and implement their action plans, including resolution of deficiencies at airports
- CAAs and Airport Operators to recruit and train adequate technical personnel
- States and Organizations to provide qualified Experts to support the implementation of the Project
