PASSENGER DATA – WHAT IS IT?

Electronic data concerning passengers' identity (API) or travel reservations (PNR) which is used by public authorities for border control.







VS

API helps identify people you know about.

For instance : people on a watchlist



PNRGOV (from PNR) helps notice people and trends you did not know about.

For instance: suspicious travel patterns

- Familiarize yourself with global standards
- Include stakeholders early



- Approach foreign States for any data protection issues
- Check that appropriate legislation is in place
- Seek assistance from experts
- **Cooperate** and remain flexible

- Interactive API is a sophisticated system that requires particularly heavy investment

What is an Insider:

- An Insider is a person who exploits or has the intention to exploit their role or knowledge for unauthorized purposes.
- ↗ All forms of staff, contractors, associates, etc.

Response Policy:

- Conduct Risk Assessment be Outcome focused
- ↗ Lay Down Basis for a Contingency Plan
