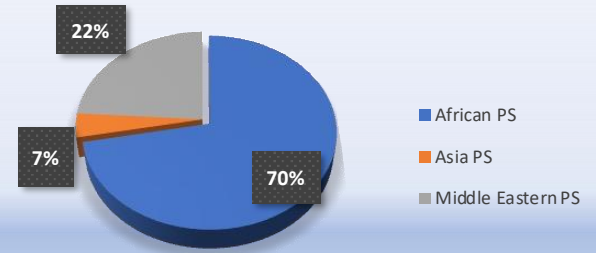

<b>Project</b>	Civil Aviation Security in Africa, the Middle East and Asia – “CASE II”
<b>Duration</b>	<b>60 Months</b> (December 2019 - November 2024) – <b>following the NCE.</b>
<b>Budget</b>	<b>EUR 8 million</b> , funded by the European Commission through the Service for <b>Foreign Policy Instruments</b>
<b>Target regions:</b>	Africa, the Middle East and Asia
<b>Final beneficiaries &amp;/or target groups</b>	<p>The goal of improved security of air transport means the final beneficiaries include: Global population (assuming any individual could be potentially affected by the consequences of acts of unlawful interference against civil aviation).</p> <p>In particular:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Users of aviation services/facilities;</li><li>• Employees of aviation services/facilities.</li></ul>
<b>Governance</b>	A Steering Group acts as the “Advisory Board” to the CASEII Project. In addition to ECAC and the European Commission, it is made up of representatives of Member States, officials of international organisations (ICAO, AFCAC, ACAO, and other sub-regional organisations) and representatives of Airports Council International (ACI) and of the International Air Transport Association (IATA).

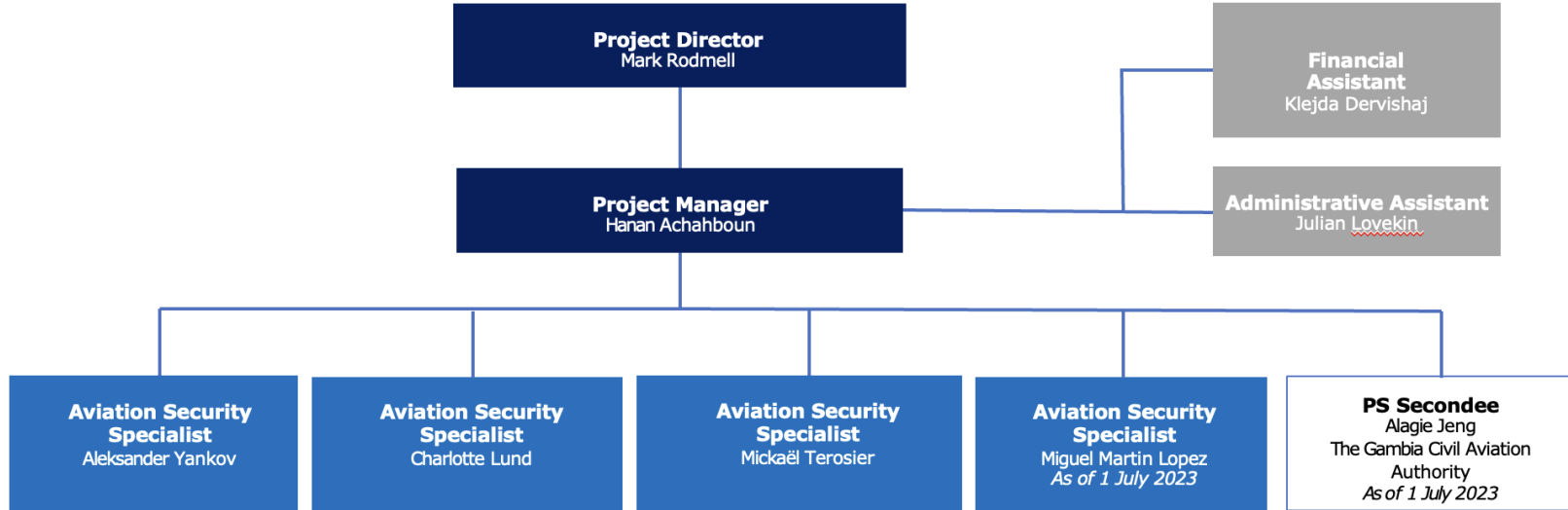

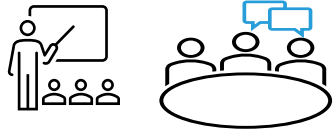

- Local experts involvement

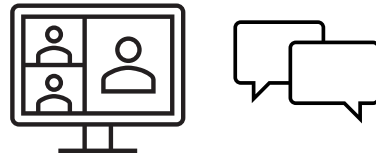


## Other activities

- APEX Reviews

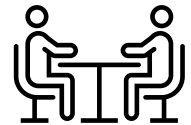
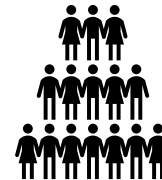
## Webinars

- Bringing together Aviation Security professionals and experts from the target regions



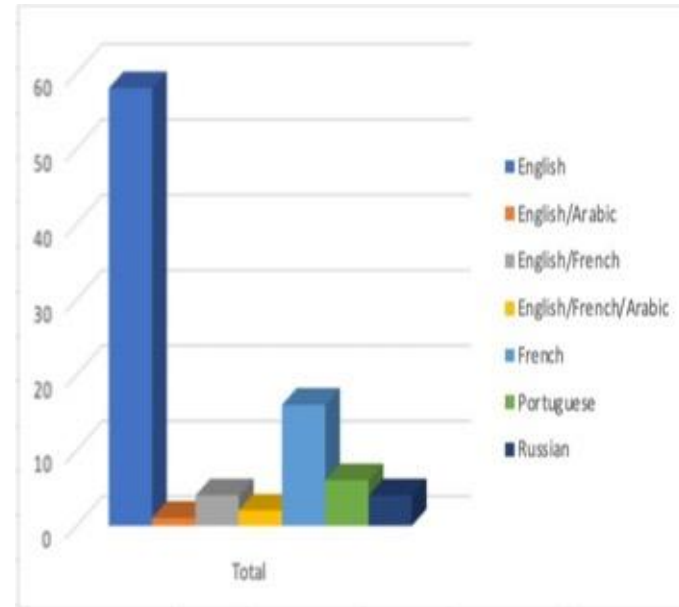
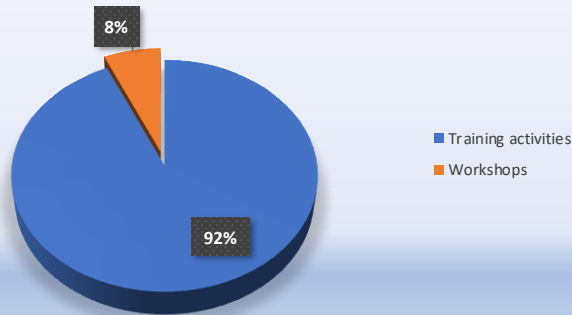
# CASE II Outreach

## Activity Delivery

- 91 activities in total
  - ✓ 57 in-country activities
  - ✓ 27 webinars
  - ✓ 7 workshops (3 remote, 4 in-person)

CASE II Activities by type (including remote)





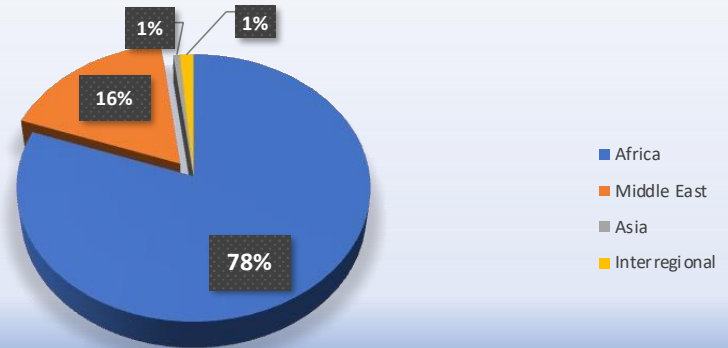
# CASE II Outreach

## Activity Delivery

67 Partner States thus far

- ✓ **More than 60% of AFCAC Member States have benefited from in country CASE II activities**
- ✓ **71 activities in Africa**
- ✓ More than 50% of ACAO Member States have benefited from in-country CASE II activities
- ✓ 14 activities in the Middle East
- ✓ 2 interregional activities (ACAO & AFCAC Member States)

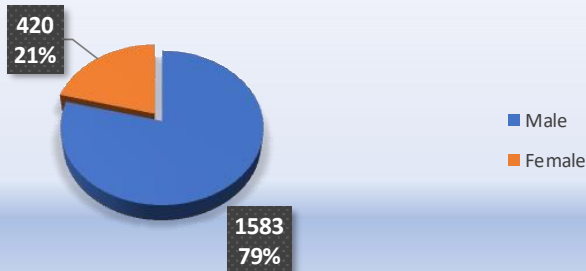
CASE II Activities by region



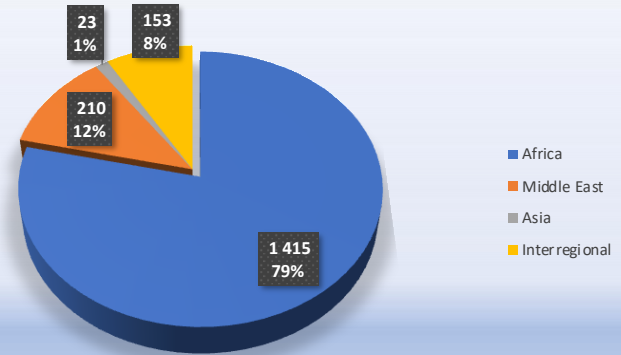
## Participants

- 31 Hosting Countries – **25 from Africa** for in-country activities
- 4 Hosting countries – **2 in Africa** for in-country regional and interregional workshops
- 754 part. for in-country activities
- 940 participants for 27 webinars undertaken & 3 remote workshops
- 309 participants for 4 workshops
