1. BACKGROUND



- Doc 9303: Machine Readable Travel Documents (TAG/MRTD)
- Doc 9303 standard formats:
 - → clearance of persons
 - → document security
 - → strengthen aviation security
 - → combat illegal migration & terrorism, etc.
- ICAO-compliant TDs secure: latest generation difficult to forge
- BUT: vulnerability in identification management

.... vulnerability in identification management

• Insecure documents used for passport application/issuance

IDENTITY FRAUD

- False identities → Genuine documents
- TAG/MRTD work: expanded to include identification management
- Expansion of the work of the MRTD Programme
- Approval of a new ICAO TRIP Strategy by A38



• Vision:

all Member States can uniquely identify individuals

• ICAO's mission:

contribute to the capacity of Member States to uniquely identify individuals by providing authorities with relevant supporting mechanisms to establish and confirm the identity of travellers



5 Elements of Traveller Identification Management

1. Evidence of identity:

- → involves tracing, linkage & verification of identity against **breeder documents**
 - → to ensure genuineness of identity

2. MRTDs:

→ design and manufacture of standardized MRTDs that comply with ICAO specifications

3. Document issuance and control:

→ processes for document issuance by appropriate authorities to authorized holders; controls to prevent theft, tampering, loss



5 Elements of traveller identification management

4. <u>Inspection systems and tools</u>:

- → inspection systems for efficient and secure reading and verification of MRTDs
 - → use of the ICAO Public Key Directory

5. <u>Interoperable applications</u>:

→ globally interoperable applications linking MRTDs and holders to relevant data in the course of inspection operations

ICAO TRIP Relevance to UN CT Strategy **Security Council Resolution 1373 (2001)**

"The Security Council . . .

- 2. Decides also that all States shall:
- (g) Prevent the movement of terrorists or terrorist groups by effective border controls and controls on issuance of identity papers and travel documents, and through measures for preventing counterfeiting, forgery or fraudulent use of identity papers and travel documents."



ICAO TRIP Relevance to UN CT Strategy Security Council Resolution 1624 (2005)

"The Security Council,

2. Calls upon all States to cooperate, inter alia, to strengthen the security of their international borders, including by combating fraudulent travel documents and, to the extent attainable, by enhancing terrorist screening and passenger security procedures with a view to preventing those guilty of committing terrorist acts from entering their territory"

Phase I: Africa: Assistance projects under preparation with several Regional Economic Communities
