## Item 3: RVSM issues: Responding to TAG queries and investigation of UCRs

#### 1. Introduction

The meeting will recall that the Special AFI RAN Meeting in 2008 endorsed the establishment of the AFI Tactical Action Group (TAG) through Recommendation 6/7 to review related safety events reported. As Secretary of the TAG group, IATA is in charge of collecting air safety reports from various sources and following up with States/ANSPs to ensure investigations are provided in time.

#### 2. Discussions

**2.1** During the course of 2014, fifty three (53) ATS incidents where Southern FIRs might be involved were reported.

Average feedback rate for these incidents is not satisfactory (estimated at 73%) despite several queries performed beside relevant authorities. Targeted feedback rate is 100% for all ATS incidents reported.


**2.2** Individual FIR performances in providing feedback are various. Some

FIRs (Johannesburg, Beira and Gaborone) provided IATA with all ATS incidents reported (feedback rate 100%) while other (Lusaka) did not come out with single investigation reports (feedback rate 0%).
