

Contingency Plan for Antananarivo FIR



INTRODUCTION

 The paper aims to present the new plan of Emergency regulations of the Antananarivo FIR and to propose its harmonization with the plans in case of contiguous situations



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 The Contingency Plan describes the relevant procedures to ensure the safety of air navigation in case of temporary unavailability of air traffic services in Antananarivo FIR in accordance with Annex 11 of ICAO (Air Traffic Services), Chapter 2, paragraph 2.28.



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In force since March 2nd 2012, this plan is intended primarily for the management of the flow of international traffic with minimal disruption to overflying traffic in the airspace under contingency. ATS routes and flight levels are established for this purpose.



DISCUSSIONS

 In case of the closure of Antananarivo FIR or disruption of air traffic services in Antananarivo CCR, aircraft operators should submit their flight plans using the contingency routes listed in the table below to ensure separation in this airspace.
