
- Harmonized approach: protocols, difference notification

Need to improve and strengthen your organization's capability to carry out safety functions



Possible actions as identified in the RAIOs and ICMs Surveys 1 & 2



Creating a repository of accident and incident investigation lessons learnt and best/good practices



Sharing safety recommendations, published reports and safety studies



Sharing information about the Peer Review methodology and the Mutual Support System



Facilitation of the ECCAIRS implementation advanced course



Interregional cooperation and/or facilitation: detect underwater locator beacons, recover and protect flight recorders, and arrange read-out, and specialist examination of equipment and materials



Supporting regions and sub-regions' States with cooperative mechanisms in progress, in coordination with the respective ICAO Regional Office



Interchanging investigators on training activities and on selected investigations, when feasible, to share and standardize procedures



Availability of training courses on specific subjects through interregional invitations and eventually through sponsorship



Model working documents and procedures for RAIOs and ICMs, and facilitation of interregional assistance in the creation of operative manuals

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Identify and agree on priority areas for cooperation Support and welcome new members and observers
