SUMMARY

- 2.2 With the outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), normal aviation operations and activities have been adversely disrupted, with focus directed to facilitating operations within the context of the pandemic thus, the negative impact on the implementation of the RASG-AFI/6 Conclusions and Decisions. The RASG-AFI/6 meeting adopted 18 Conclusions and 20 Decisions, the status of implementation of which is provided in the **Appendix** to this paper. The RASC has to re-strategies for the implementation of these Conclusions and Decisions during and post-COVID-19 era. The implementation of these Conclusions and Decisions will be pursued appropriately and their status of implementation reported to the RASC and RASG-AFI on a regular basis.
- 2.3 The activities of the RASG-AFI are mainly categorized under the framework of the four Safety Support Teams (Significant Safety Concerns, Fundamentals of Safety Oversight, Investigation of Aircraft Accidents and Serious Incidents, Emerging Safety Issues) so as to promote RASG-AFI safety performance and attainment of the regional safety targets in a sustainable manner.
- 2.4 It is important to note that some of the activities are continual in nature and therefore, their status of implementation remains on-going. Notwithstanding, the levels of implementation will be provided accordingly.
