#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The RASG-AFI Steering Committee (RASC) was established to guide the work of the Group and to ensure that safety initiatives are accomplished in a timely, effective and efficient manner. In this regard, the RASC was mandated, amongst other things, to propose an Annual Work Programme in addition to ensuring that the activities of the Group are properly coordinated.

#### 2. DISCUSSIONS

- 2.1 RASG-AFI Activities and Future Work programmes require RASC to exercise flexibility, at its discretion, on the contents and frequency of its activities whilst considering, the logical chronology and sequence for effective implementation. Therefore, the proposed 2023 activities were developed with these objectives in mind.
- 2.2 The proposed 2023 Activities cover those of the RASC, the Safety Support Teams (SSTs) and RASG-AFI meetings. The revised terms of reference for APIRG and RASG-AFI, the restructuring of the SSTs, and the new working arrangement of the Groups' Meetings (Joint Opening and Closing Plenaries and sessions in-between) have necessitated the amendment

of the RASG-AFI Procedural Handbook. This working arrangement is intended to ensure proper coordination between the Groups and ensure that all safety activities at the regional and sub-regional levels are properly coordinated amongst actors to avoid duplication of efforts.

2.3 With the restructuring of the Safety Support Teams to better align their functions to the Goals and Targets of the current Edition of the GASP; and give the States the leadership role and ownership of the activities of the Teams, the key focus areas will include but not limited to, the development and subsequent implementation of the Regional Aviation Safety Plan for the region (AFI-RASP); and the assistance to be provided to States by the Regional Offices and other stakeholders to develop and implement their National Aviation Safety Plans (NASPs), in alignment with the AFI-RASP and the GASP.
