1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The guidance provided in the Generic Terms of Reference of Planning and Implementation Regional Groups (PIRGs) call for PIRGs to ensure that the PIRG meeting reports is provided in a standardized format to the governing bodies of ICAO to identify regional and emerging challenges. It is also recalled that these reports should include amongst others, a list of items for coordination with the RASG and a concise summary of the outcome of related discussions.

2. DISCUSSIONS

- 2.1. The fifth meeting of the APIRG IIM sub-group (APIRG IIM/SG5), held virtually from 26 to 29 July 2022, did not identify any actions requiring coordination with the RSAG-AFI SSTs.
- 2.2. The IIM/SG6 Meeting has discussed amongst other, actions to further facilitate regional planning and implementation activities, the AFI Air Navigation Plan, Air Navigation Deficiencies in AIM, CNS and MET areas, the status of the implementation of APIRG Projects as well as ASBU elements, for which the States' reporting level is still low in the region.

- 2.3. The IIM/SG6 meeting took actions to address issues and challenges identified in the area of capacity and efficiency. Some of these actions may be safety related and the meeting should consider this likely situation accordingly.
