

Prosper ZO'O MINTO'O, ICAO, Deputy Regional Director, Eastern and Southern African Office (November 2013/May 2016) and Deputy Regional Director, Western and Central African Office (since June 2016)

Mr. Prosper ZO'O MINTO'O has now been serving the international civil aviation community for 32 years, including ICAO, airline industry, air navigation services and airports.

Prior to his current position, he has worked with ICAO for 13 years, at the Western and Central African Office (Dakar), and the Eastern and Southern African Office (Nairobi) as Regional Officer, Communications, Navigation and Surveillance, from 1999 to 2008, and from 2010 to 2013. In that capacity, he has served as Secretary to various Expert Groups at regional and interregional levels.

Prosper ZO'O MINTO'O is involved in major global and regional aviation programmes aimed at strengthening aviation safety performance, improving air navigation capacity and efficiency, and enhancing civil aviation security. He an auditor under the ICAO Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme (USOAP).

In addition to his experience with ICAO, Prosper ZO'O MINTO'O had worked with the International Air Transport Association (IATA) as Deputy Regional Director, Safety, Operations and Infrastructure, AFI (2008-2010), and with the Agency for the Safety of Aerial Navigation in Africa and Madagascar (ASECNA) at key managerial positions (1985-1999).
