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U.S. DOT's Safe Skies for Africa Program

- An early supporter of RSOOs in Africa
 - Assisted several African COSCAPs transitions to RSOOs
 - For example, Safe Skies supported the establishment of the Civil Aviation Safety and Security Oversight Organization (CASSOA)
- A continuous partner
 - Providing training and technical assistance
 - Support for the development of harmonized, ICAO-endorsed Model Laws and Regulations (MCARs), including French translations
 - Creation and delivery of the Inspector Training System (now enhanced by BAGASOO's ITRAQS)









Safe Skies for Africa's Vision for RSOO Success

- Political will and financial resources must be dedicated/committed.
- But must also look at training and cultural elements of RSOOs
 - RSOOs are more than just treaties and political compromise, they are made up of the staff of the CAAs. They need to feel a part of the RSOO.
 - Safe Skies focusing on regional training that brings personnel together
 - Pilot project to create a regional training center of excellence that will train all new hire inspectors for the region
 - Using common training and practices to build a common purpose for member CAAs of RSOO









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
