1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Terms of Reference of the RASG-MID Steering Committee (RSC) stipulate that the RSC propose the RASG-MID work programme.
- 1.2 The RASG-MID work programme for 2013 will be prepared by the RSC and presented to the RASG-MID annual meeting in November 2012 for adoption.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 In order to prepare the work programme for 2013, the RSC proposes that we focus on activities that will contribute to reduce the risks of Runway Safety, and LOC for 2013.
- 2.2 We organize regional and national workshops targeting the safety officers, and training officers in airlines, airports, ANS organizations, and ground operations responsible for managing the identified risks in their daily operations.
- 2.3 The proposed calendar for the preparation is the following:
 - a) all stakeholders to send to the Coordinators their proposals before end July 2012;
 - b) the coordinators will work with the Co-Chairs before end of August, to avoid duplications; and
 - c) the Co-Chairs and the Coordinators will work with the Secretariat on eventual funding issues, in order to have a document ready end of September.

- 2.4 The funding issue will be addressed with eventual donors and sponsors, and through the ICAO SAFE fund, giving priority to regional initiatives.
- 2.5 The final and coordinated plan will be presented and discussed at the annual RASG-MID meeting in November 2012.

3. ACTION BY THE MEETING

- 3.1 The meeting is invited to:
 - a) adopt this proposal; and
 - b) invite all stakeholders to collaborate to its implementation.
