1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Second meeting of the RASG Steering Committee (RSC/2) was held in Amman, Jordan, from 28 to 30 October 2013. The meeting was attended by a total of eighteen (18) participants from seven (7) States (Egypt, Iran, Jordan, Oman, Saudi Arabia, and United Arab Emirates, United States of American-FAA) and four (4) Organizations/Industries (Boeing, COSCAP-GS, IATA and WFP).
- 1.2 The Procedural Handbook is a publication prepared by the Secretariat intended to provide, for easy reference of all interested parties, a consolidation of material, particularly of a procedural nature, relevant to the work of the RASG-MID and its contributory bodies. It contains the working arrangements and internal instructions developed by the Group for the practical application of its Terms of Reference and working methods.
- 1.3 The RASG-MID Procedural Handbook Second Edition November 2012, has been issued and posted on the ICAO Middle East Regional Office website based on the outcome of the RASG-MID/2 meeting (Abu Dhabi, UAE, 12 14 November 2012).

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 The RSC/2 meeting proposed the establishment of the Runway and Ground Safety Working Group (RGS WG) under the MID-RAST.
- 2.2 The RSC/2 meeting recognized the need to review and update the RASG-MID Procedural Handbook to reflect the establishment of the RGS WG and agreed that an updated version of the Organizational Structure should be presented to the RASG-MID/3 meeting for approval.
- 2.3 Based on the above, an updated RASG-MID Organizational Structure has been prepared, as at **Appendix A** to this working paper. The new Organizational Structure will be part of the revised RASG-MID Procedural Handbook.

3. ACTION BY THE MEETING

- 3.1 The meeting is invited to:
 - a) endorse the new RASG-MID Organizational Structure at Appendix A; and
 - b) task the Secretariat to prepare the Third Edition of the RASG-MID Procedural Handbook taking into consideration the new Organizational Structure and the latest developments in RASG-MID working arrangements.
