## Management of Public Health Emergencies (PHE) Risk By EGYPTAIR





#### Procedures to be Implemented in affected regions





- Crew members should prevent the spread of virus diseases (VD) by following these procedures:
- 1- Pre- flight announcement to passenger shall include precautionary methods.
- 2- Egypt Air shall provide First aid kits, universal precaution kits, a stock of triple layer masks, disposable hand gloves, hand sanitizer and Biohazard Plastic bag.
- 3- Distributing the follow-up health card (Public Health Passenger Locator Card) to passengers holding the nationality of infected countries or recently had visited suspected area.





# Cabin Crew procedures to identify, evaluate and manage passengers with a suspected communicable diseases





- Guidance material disseminated to crew members for specific public health measures for passengers suspected with Virus Disease (VD)(e.g. Ebola)
- Distancing other passengers if possible away from the symptomatic passenger (re-seating); while allocating infected passengers seats, preferably near a toilet, for their exclusive use.





- Covering nose and mouth of the infected passengers with a surgical facemask.
- Limiting contact with passengers to the minimum necessary. Designated, one or two cabin crew members to provide assistance, service if needed. Immediate notification to Pilot in command.
- Hand washing with soap after any direct or indirect contact with the suspected infected passenger.





- Immediate isolation of passenger upon arrival & to be the last passenger to leave the aircraft.
- Passengers seated in vicinity, including seated across the aisle, of the suspected infected passenger and those who were in direct contact, would be the main source of transmission of Virus Disease (VD)(e.g Ebola), therefore shall be included in the contact tracing list.





# Pilot-in –command Procedures to promptly notify ATC of in-flight suspected communicable diseases case





The Pilot in command shall notify immediately, authorities at the destination airport Local/ International flights in accordance to the specified Operation Manual procedures (as defined in the ICAO regulations) of contagious disease or potential cases, death or illnesses among passengers or crew members to the nearest airport or airport of arrival.
